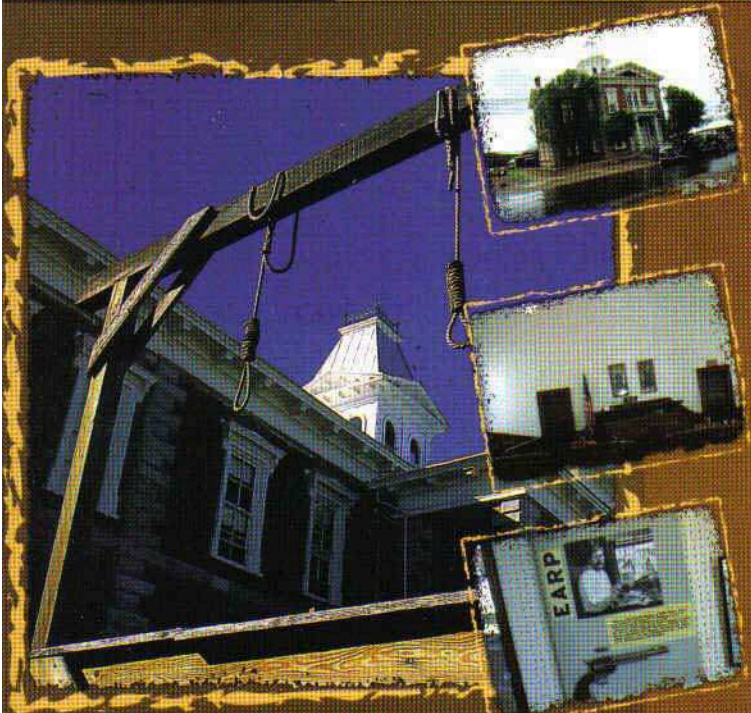


# Tombstone Courthouse

State Historic Park



There is no better place to get a glimpse of the True Old West than Tombstone Courthouse State Historic Park. Today, the old County Courthouse is a museum filled with the glitter and the guns of those who tamed the territory. Huge rooms inside the 12,000 square foot, two story Victorian structure house exhibits about Tombstone's past glory days as a frontier silver mining boomtown. Tax licenses for operating a brothel to invitation to a hanging are items that can be found on display. A replica gallows can be found in the Courtyard, where seven men were hanged.



Built in the shape of a Roman cross, the 1882 Victorian structure once housed the offices of the Sheriff, Recorder, Treasurer, Board of Supervisors, Jail and Courtrooms of Cochise County

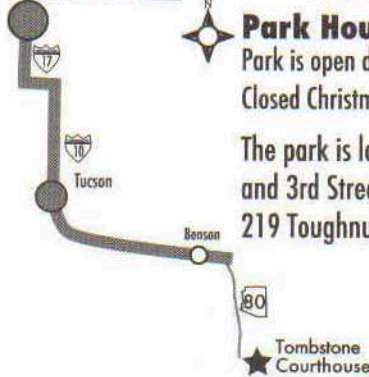

The park is located on the corner of Toughnut and 3rd Streets, 2 blocks off of Highway 80 at 219 Toughnut Street.

World's largest rose tree at the Rose Tree Inn, OK Corral, Boot Hill, Fort Huachuca (1877 Calvary Post Museum), Chiricahua National Monument, Tonto National Forest, Dos Cabezas, Cochise Stronghold

Kartchner Caverns State Park®, Patagonia Lake State Park, Roper Lake State Park, and Tubac Presidio State Historic Park.
